



University of Missouri Sports Camp Waivers/Authorizations

Liability Waiver/Assumption of Risks & Participation:

The _____ sports camp is owned, sponsored, operated by the University of Missouri (MU). Camps are open to any and all entrants limited only by age, level, gender, and/or number.

I am aware of the dangers involved in participation in the physical activities of an athletic camp and all activities related to the camp; these activities include, without limitation, practices and events. I am aware this camp may involve physical contact. With regard to such physical activity, I am aware that there is inherent danger and risk of injury. I also am aware that many of these injuries may be serious and may include, without limitation, damages to joints, ligaments, muscles, bones, neck, spine and other parts of the body.

Further, I am aware that activities related to the camp will involve the use of certain equipment. I am aware that such equipment in no way guarantees my safety from injury. Additionally, said equipment must be used in a proper manner; therefore, I will follow any and all instructions related to the use of equipment including those instructions provided by the manufacturer, equipment personnel and coaches.

My participation in the above events and in all activities related to the above events is a voluntary act with full and complete knowledge of the risks involved. I hereby voluntarily assume all such risks associated with my participation in the above events. Additionally, I agree to exonerate, save, indemnify, and hold harmless the camp, its owners, employees, and volunteers; MU its officers, agents, and employees – including without limitation, equipment personnel, and physicians and other practitioners of the healing arts - from any and all liability, claims, causes of action or demands of any kind and nature whatsoever, including without limitation personal injury which may arise from or in connection with my participation in any activities related to the camp.

The terms hereof shall serve as a release and assumption of risk for me, my parents or guardian, my heirs, estate, executor, administrator, assignees, and all members of my family. I have read and understand this acknowledgment and release and execute it as a free and voluntary act.

Further, this acknowledgment and release is contractual and not a mere recital.

Medical Treatment Authorization:

Athletic training staff will treat minor injuries typical to athletic participation and will monitor participant hydration. Campers are encouraged to have their own health insurance as well as review the information located on MUtigers.com regarding hydration and concussions.

I/We being the parent(s) and/or guardian of the applicant authorize MU and its agent's permission to request emergency medical treatment or care necessary to issue the well-being of our dependent.

Further, I claim the registrant has had a physical examination and was found fit for all physical endeavors.

Camper Expectation Information:

MU is proud to sponsor summer sports camps and we are very pleased to have you attend as a camper. In order to ensure that your experience is safe and enjoyable, we require all campers to abide by a strict code of conduct. Lack of adherence to these policies constitutes grounds for expulsion.

As a MU Sports Camp Participant, I agree that I will:

- Participate and cooperate in all camp activities (including camp meals). Only the camp director may grant permission to be excused from a camp activity. Attendance will be taken.
- Respect all safety guidelines required by camp staff and MU.
- Follow the camp schedule, including curfew, wake-up and lights-out policies.
- Wear appropriate clothing and shoes during all activities.
- Lock my dorm room whenever I leave, even for a short time. MU Sport Camps are not responsible for campers' lost or stolen items.
- Notify camp staff whenever a problem arises, whether big or small.
- Abide by all camp rules and policies, as well as all federal/state laws.

I agree that I will not:

- Use profanity or inappropriate language, whether it is written or verbal.
- Allow visitors into the dormitory or dining areas.
- Possess and/or use alcohol, tobacco, or illegal substances.
- Possess matches, lighters, hot plates, fireworks, weapons, or other objects that the camp director deems dangerous.
- Possess and/or distribute indecent literature or images.
- Tamper with fire alarms, safety, or security equipment.
- Damage or steal University or other people's property.
- Harass, bully, or intimidate other campers or staff.
- Engage in excessive noisemaking or horseplay.
- Have romantic relationships with camp staff or other campers.
- Sleep in any dorm room other than the one assigned.

To ensure that everyone has a positive experience while participating in a MU sport camp, campers are expected to behave in a disciplined, responsible, and respectful manner at all times, whether on or off the MU campus. Failure to follow these rules and regulations will subject the campers to immediate disciplinary action, including dismissal from camp. **Refunds will NOT be given for any campers dismissed from camp for failing to follow these guidelines.**

By signing this document, I agree that I have read, fully understand, and agree to follow the Camper Rules and Expectations while attending MU's Sports Camps.

Photo & Video Authorization:

I hereby consent to and authorize the use and reproduction, in print or electronic format by MU of any and all photographs which have been taken for any publicity purpose without compensation. All electronic images, together with the prints, are owned by MU. I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand these terms.

I authorize MU to make pictures and sound recordings of my child/children in this account and use the same in any form for its purposes and consent that the pictures and recordings may be copied, published, telecast or broadcast for such purposes together with descriptions and editorial statements. Residence Halls:
