

Dear Parent/Guardian and Camper,

This letter will provide you with all the details of World Class Field Hockey Advanced Camp on July 16-18 at Yale University. Yale University's Johnson Field is an outstanding Astroturf facility. The Carol Roberts Field House (CRFH), dedicated in 2018, is adjacent to Johnson Field and is home to the field hockey and softball teams. The CRFH has public restrooms, a visiting locker room, meeting space, and Yale team space including team locker rooms, training room and satellite coaches office. It will be utilized during camp to serve meals, hold meetings, etc. Residents will be housed at the University of New Haven (UNH), a little over a mile from Johnson Field. The World Class Field Hockey staff (coaches, athletic trainer and residence supervisors) will be housed at the UNH. There will be complete supervision at ALL times by our staff members.

REFUND POLICY: World Class Sports LLC has a NO REFUND POLICY. Medical withdrawals are honored one week prior to the start of camp. A letter from your doctor must accompany the request and your camp fee will be refunded, minus a \$100 processing fee.

Registration

Registration will be on Thursday, July 16 from 12:00-1:00pm at University of New Haven's Westside Hall. Registration for ALL campers, including commuters, will take place at the University of New Haven.

Departure

Departure will be at University of New Haven's Westside Hall on Saturday, July 18 from 4:00-5:00pm. Commuters can depart from Johnson Field at the close of camp.

Lodging

Residents will be housed for two nights (Thursday and Friday) at University of New Haven's Westside Hall. Westside Hall has air conditioning so it is not necessary to bring fans. There are no kitchenettes or refrigerators in the rooms.

Meals

The first meal will be dinner on July 16 and the last meal will be lunch on July 18. Meals will be served at the University of New Haven's Westside Hall and Yale's Carol Roberts Field House. Commuters will be provided lunch and dinner.

REQUIRED FORMS: Medical Form

Please complete the attached **Medical Form**. Please email, fax or mail forms prior to camp. You may use a medical form from school, another camp, activity, etc., however, the form must be completed and signed by a doctor and parent/guardian in order to participate. Connecticut State Law requires all campers to have an updated physical and medical form on file to participate.

If you are bringing medication to camp you must download and complete the **Authorization for Medication Form** found on the WCS website. This form must be signed by your doctor. Campers must self-administer all medications.

Bus Transportation to/from Field

ALL campers (commuters as well as residents) and staff will be transported by bus to/from University of New Haven and Yale University between playing sessions.

Camp Store

There will be a Camp Store open during breaks. Yale Field Hockey and World Class Field Hockey T-shirts, shorts, hockey sticks, etc. as well as food and drink will be available for purchase. A **Camp Store Bank** will be available for campers to deposit money to purchase items. We will keep a running account of expenditures. This will eliminate you having to carry money around. Balance of deposit must be picked-up prior to departure from camp.

Directions to the University of New Haven

300 Boston Post Rd. West Haven, CT 06516

From New York and Points West:

Connecticut Turnpike (I-95) Northbound. Take Exit 43, Campbell Avenue. Turn left at bottom of exit ramp. Continue past University of New Haven sign on left at Ruden Street (0.6 miles) to intersection with Route 1 (Boston Post Road). Turn left, travel to top of hill, turn left into the University of New Haven.

Merritt/Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15) Northbound:

Take Exit 57, Route 34 east (Derby Avenue) Travel 3.4 miles to Route 122 (Forest Road). Turn right, travel 1.0 miles to first traffic light, Route 1 (Boston Post Road). Turn right, travel to top of hill, turn left into the University of New Haven.

From Hartford, Boston, Providence, New London, and Points North and East:

NOTE: From Southbound I-91, remain on highway and follow to juncture with I-95 Southbound (toward New York City). Follow directions below.

Connecticut Turnpike (I-95) Southbound: Take Exit 43, First Avenue. Turn right at bottom of exit ramp, travel 0.5 miles to second traffic light, Route 122 (Campbell Avenue). Turn right and continue past intersection with Ruden Street (note University of New Haven sign at left) to intersection with Route 1 (Boston Post Road). Travel to top of hill, turn left into the University of New Haven.

Merritt/Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15) Southbound: Take Exit 57, Route 34 East (Derby Avenue) Travel 3.4 miles to Route 122 (Forest Road). Turn right, travel 1.0 miles to first traffic light, Route 1 (Boston Post Road). Turn right, travel to top of hill, turn left into the University of New Haven.

From MERRITT and WILBUR CROSS PARKWAYS:

- Take Exit 57 (Route 34 East) directly to the Yale Bowl Complex
- **OR** Take Exit 59 (Whalley Ave.) and follow the Yale Bowl signs
- Pass through Forrest Road and the car dealerships. At the next traffic signal take a left on Central Ave.
- Take your first left on the service road. Follow road back to the parking lot at Johnson Field.

From INTERSTATE 95:

- Take Eastbound Exit 44 or Westbound Exit 45 to Route 10 (follow the signs posted for the Yale Bowl)
- **OR** take Exit 47 (Downtown) and follow Route 34 to the Yale Bowl Complex
- Follow the signs posted for the Yale Bowl
- Pass Smilow Field House on your right directly adjacent to the Yale Bowl Walter Camp Entrance on Derby Ave. (Route 34)
- At the next traffic light take a right on Central Ave.
- Take your first left on the service road. Follow road back to the parking lot at Johnson Field.

From INTERSTATE 91 Southbound:

- Take Exit 1 (Downtown) and follow Route 34 to the Yale Bowl Complex
- Follow signs posted for the Yale Bowl
- Pass Smilow Field House on your right adjacent to the Yale Bowl Walter Camp Entrance on Derby Ave. (Route 34)
- At the next traffic light take a right on Central Ave.
- Take your first left on the service road adjacent to the Armory. Follow road back to the parking lot at Johnson Field.

From DOWNTOWN New Haven:

- Go north on Chapel Street, then bear left on to Derby Avenue (Route 34) to the Yale Bowl
- Smilow Field House is located on your right adjacent to the Yale Bowl Walter Camp Entrance on Derby Ave. (Route 34)
- At the next traffic light take a right on Central Ave.
- Take your first left on the service road. Follow road back to the parking lot at Johnson Field.
