## What are the age limits for camp?

Missouri Sports Camps are open to any and all entrants, limited only by capacity, age, grade level, or gender. Each registration page will provide additional information about any applicable limits.

## When is the deadline to sign up for camp?

Please refer to the camp registration page and/or FAQs for more information about the registration window.

# What forms of payment are accepted, and when is payment due for camp?

Online registration is strongly encouraged to assist with planning and staffing for Missouri Sports Camps. Online camp registrants can pay all camp fees via credit card and should make payment at the time registration is completed. Some camps may permit walk-up registration the day of camp, in which case payment should be made at the time of check-in. Payment by credit card is preferred for walk-up registration. Please refer to the camp registration website and/or FAQs for more information about the registration process and payments, as some camps may not accept walk-up registrations.

# Is there a processing fee when registering?

There is a 6% service fee assessed for online registration. The service fee may incorporated into the camp registration fee or may be a separate fee, depending on the camp.

## Are refunds available?

Generally, refunds are only available within a certain timeframe (e.g., 48 hours) prior to the start of camp. Please refer to the camp registration website and/or FAQs for more information about refunds.

## Are any discounts provided for camps?

## Who are the camp coaches and counselors?

University of Missouri coaches and student-athletes serve as camp coaches and counselors. On occasion, coaches from other universities and other national or elite coaches may be hired to work at Missouri Sports Camps. All camp employees complete a robust screening process and must meet all screening requirements prior to working camp.

# What is the difference between a residential camper and commuter camper?

Any camp participant registered as a residential camper will stay overnight in a Universityowned dorm for the duration of the camp. Participants registered as commuter campers will receive a similar camp experience but will not stay overnight on campus. Commuter campers must be dropped off and picked up each day of the camp.

### Who supervises residential campers overnight?

Camp coaches and counselors will stay in the dorms with and supervisor campers who are attending an overnight camp. Residential Life may also have staff housed in the dorms and/or will have on-call staff available.

## Can a specific roommate be requested?

Please refer to the camp registration website and/or FAQs for more information about requesting roommates. The camp director can also assist with additional questions about roommates.

## What should my camper bring?

Requirements may vary by camp. Please refer to the camp registration website and/or FAQs for more information about what items campers should bring. The camp director can also assist with additional questions about what items are required.

### When and where should I drop off my camper to check-in on the first day of camp?

Drop off and check-in locations will vary by camp. Please refer to the camp registration website and/or FAQs for more information about drop off/check-in and be on the lookout for follow up information once registration has been completed. The camp director can also assist with additional questions about drop off/check in.

What should I do if I am running late, if I will miss the designated camp check-in/check-out time, or there is an emergency?

Please contact the camp director as soon as possible.

## What if my camper has allergies or dietary restrictions?

During registration, you can list any allergies to foods, medications, et cetera, that your camper may have. Please be sure to include all pertinent information during the registration process, so the camp director is aware of any restrictions and can plan accordingly.

#### How do I get to my camp?

Maps and driving directions are provided on the camp registration page under Facilities. The camp director can also assist with any questions about location or traveling to campus.

## Where can I park during camp?

Parking locations will vary by camp, but many parking lots around the Mizzou Sports Park and on-campus are restricted to permit holders only, at least from Monday through Friday between 7 AM and 6 PM. More information about parking enforcement and parking permissions is available through <u>Parking & Transportation</u>. You may be able to arrange for temporary parking permissions by contacting Parking & Transportation at <u>muparking@missouri.edu</u> or 573-882-4568, but please check with the camp director to confirm if there is a recommended parking location or if parking has been included in the cost of camper registration. Can I stay to watch camp?

Whether or not a camp is open for family to watch will vary by camp. Please refer to the camp registration website and/or FAQs for more information about whether a camp is open. The camp director can also assist with additional questions viewing camps.

How do I get updates or notification of changes to camps?

All updates or notifications of changes to camps should be communicated to you by the camp director.
